How to Play

MORE WAYS TO PLAY

Solo Show: Skip the head-to-head component. Players draw a card and perform by themselves. Everyone else votes using their Talent Tokens on each performance. Each audience member should give one (and only one) Talent Token to the performer.

Best of Show: Every time a talent card is drawn, all players do the talent on the card. When every player has finished performing, players give one Talent Token to their favorite performance (anyone but themselves).

30 Second Talent: Play the game with the standard rules, but set a time limit for 30 seconds for any Talent Challenge that doesn't already include a time limit (e.g., the fast-draw challenges). This increases the fun factor and keeps the game moving quickly!

Team Showdown (6+ players): Split the players into three or more teams. Each team (not team member) gets **4 of each color Talent Token and 1 Star Card**.

1. Pick a team to go first. One member of the team rolls the dice and draws a **Talent Challenge Card**.
2. The team nominates one player to perform the Talent Challenge. Other teams serve as audience members.
3. When the performance is finished, the non-performing teams vote using **ONE Talent Token per team**.
4. Play continues clockwise until all teams have filled their Star Card (4 performances). The team with the most points at the end is the winner!

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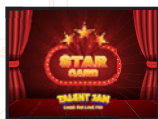

OBJECTIVE

Players complete wacky talent challenges. Other players vote for their favorites. The player with the most points at the end wins!

SET UP

- 1 Separate the **Talent Challenge Cards** into four separate decks by color and then shuffle each deck.
- 2 Give each player 1 **Swap** card, 1 **Star** card, and 6 **Talent Tokens** of each shape/color.
- 3 Get paper and two pencils that players can use for drawing challenges. If you don't have these handy, remove the **Green (Draw) Talent Challenge** cards from the game and skip these rolls.

GAMEPLAY

- 1 Pick a player to go first. Roll the dice and draw a **Talent Challenge Card** from the deck that matches the color rolled (e.g., **red** = move). The multicolor circle (🎲) is player's choice.
- 2 The player reads the card they selected out loud. In a **3 player game**, the player who rolled the dice performs the talent. In a **4+ player game**, the player chooses someone to join them in a head-to-head talent competition. The two players take turns doing the same talent in their own funny and unique way!
- ! If a player wants to skip a talent challenge, they can use their **Swap** card **once per game** to pick someone else to go in their place.
- 3 When the performer(s) are finished, the audience members vote using their **Talent Tokens**. Players rate **how funny and creative each player's** performance was by giving exactly **one Talent Token** to each performer. Different Talent Tokens are worth different points.

1 Red = 1 point

3 Blue = 3 points

5 Green = 5 points

For Example: Max and Kelly do a drawing challenge. You really liked Max's drawing and give him the 5 point token (green). You thought Kelly also did a great job and give her the 3 point token (blue). Other audience members also give Max and Kelly one token each.

You can give out tokens in any combination (e.g., both players can get a green token) but each performer must get one token from each audience member. **Save your green tokens for REALLY stellar performances!**

- 4 Performers place **Talent Tokens they earned** on their **Star Card**. All tokens earned in their **first** performance go on **star coin #1**. For the player's second performance, they place all tokens on star coin #2, and so on. Players use the Star Card to keep track of how many times they have performed and their Talent Token score for each performance. **Tokens on a Star Card are "out of play" and can NOT be used to vote for other player's performances.**



- 5 After voting is finished, play continues clockwise. The next player rolls the dice, picks a talent challenge card, and chooses someone to challenge (4+ player games only). Once a player has done 4 performances and their **Star Card is full**, they cannot do any more challenges and must skip their turn. **The game ends when all players have a full Star Card.**

! **Note:** In a **five player game**, the last person to draw a Talent Challenge Card will need to perform by themselves because all possible partners will have a full Star Card.

SCORING

The player with the highest **Talent Token** score at the end is the winner. Remember to count each red token as 1 point, each blue token as 3 points, and each green token as 5 points.



For more fun, discuss the performances as a group and give players different superlatives. For example, **Funniest, Surprising, or Most Unique Performance.**
